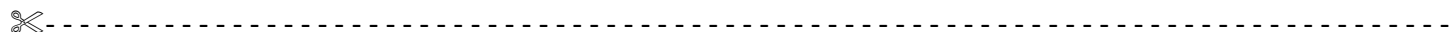

Basics of Longarm Quilting – Day 1 Morning Class

Class Description: Does longarm quilting interest you, and you'd like to learn more about it? Or do you just want a review of longarm quilting basics? This class removes the mystery of longarm quilting by explaining machine and frame elements and features, how to load a quilt, and vital facts about thread, needles, and tension. Handi Quilter longarm machine and frame systems come in various sizes for every budget and are user-friendly because they are designed by a quilter, for quilters – just like you! **Objective:** Gain confidence needed to finish your quilt tops with the longarm through preparation, applying designs and managing tension.

Topics Include:

- How to prepare the quilt top and backing for quilting
- How to select, resize, audition, and apply quilt designs
- Stitch-in-the-ditch and meander quilting
- Threads, needles, and tension
- Batting and basting basics

Rule(r) Your Quilts! – Day 1 Afternoon Class

Class Description: If you love precision and consistency in your quilting rulers, you will love using design rulers and templates! These handy tools assist in placing designs accurately and stitching them out precisely. Learn to handle rulers and templates safely with the ruler base and Sure Foot, and how to achieve accuracy with the markings. The wide variety of Handi Quilter rulers will inspire you to new design heights. **Objective:** Learn the safe way to use rulers & templates. See ways that you can incorporate these tools in your quilting.

Topics Include:

- Handle rulers safely
- Understand and use ruler markings for precision and accuracy
- Use piecing lines and marking tools to build ruler design confidence
- VersaTool, quilting, stitch-in-the-ditch, crosshatch, piano keys, clamshells, and arcs
- Apply binding with the HQ VersaTool

Exploring Pro-Stitcher in Simulation – Day 2 – Full Day

Class Description: Pro-Stitcher is an intuitive computer-guided quilting system designed especially for use with Handi Quilter longarm quilting machines. User-friendly and simple to operate, the step-by-step process for each function is easy and fun. Whether finishing your own quilts or consider a quilting business, come see the elegant and precise quilting you can accomplish with Pro-Stitcher. New users – start here! **Objective:** Students learn the basics of Pro-Stitcher in simulation by following along or watching demonstrations of Pro-Stitcher features and the basic overview of PS Designer and Catalog.

- Create an area and place a block using Skew, Resize, XForm & Align
- Demo how to set up an e2e design, including wrapped and cropped designs
- What's the difference between Reposition, Nudge, and Drag and Drop

- Making designs fit in all spaces with the Modify tools
- Overview of PS Designer & PS Catalog

PSD – LD1: PS Designer Basics – Day 3 Morning Class

Class Description: Pro-Stitcher Designer is full featured, vector-based drawing software which gives you the ability to quickly design, edit, customize, export, and import any quilting motif you can imagine. This class will start with a basic overview of the easy-to-use features. New users will be creating their own digital designs for their next quilting project by the end of this class! Objective: Students will understand how to find support and other resources for PS Designer, along with the basics of how the software functions.

Topics include:

- Overview of support resources available online
- Overview of user interface, basic functions, and design catalog
- Draw basic designs using the Draw tools then add stitches and save
- Bring in a backdrop and layout a quilt
- Basic editing of designs to make them fit any space

Gridwork Not Guesswork – Day 3 Afternoon Class

Class Description: Laying out designs using gridwork creates even spacing and uniformity in quilting. In this workshop, you'll learn how to make your own stencils, explore designs that work well within grids, and tips and tricks for marking grids on your next quilting project. Objective: Quilting with a grid result in even spacing and uniformity with your quilting.

Topics can include:

- Making your own grid stencil
- Applying grids successfully in different size spaces
- Designs conducive for gridwork
- Gridwork for E2E designs
- Marking and removing grids

Mark It Up – Day 3 – Final Class

Class Description: This workshop walks you through the steps of marking your quilt top successfully. You'll get lots of tips and tricks on how to find the perfect design and be able to transfer it to your quilt top at the proper scale and with the tools that are just right for your project. Objective: Transferring designs to your quilt top is easy with the right tools. Learn how to successfully use stencils and how to create your own.

- Find the perfect design
- Scale design to size
- Marking tools for success
- Create your own stencils
- Tips for free motion quilting with stencils
